Training provider information

Does this training course support the work of the Every Child Matters and the Children's Workforce agendas?

Yes. This course supports the Every Child Matters five outcomes for children from a playwork perspective. It is an ideal training opportunity for anyone over the age of 16 years and can be used as a stepping stone from the 'Making Choices' and 'Take 5 for Play' courses.

Everyone Can Play aims to:

- enable students to develop confidence and competence in working with disabled and non-disabled children aged 4-16 years in their leisure time.
- give students an understanding of Inclusive Play issues and Playwork Values.
- provides valuable underpinning knowledge to support students wishing to register as a candidate for the NVQ level 2 in Playwork.

What does Everyone Can Play cover?

This 12.5 hour tutor led course which is usually delivered over 5 sessions covers:

- Introduction session, getting to know you
- Disability equality
- Children's well-being
- Equality of opportunity
- Planning for inclusive play

Students are encouraged to undertake some personal study and if possible make visits to other inclusive play settings.

Who can deliver Everyone Can Play?

Any playwork tutor who has a stage one further adult education teaching certificate can deliver this course. They must also have relevant experience working with disabled children and have successfully undertaken Everyone Can Play tutor training.

How do training providers register to run an Everyone Can Play course?

Training providers are asked to complete an application, which will be sent upon request. Completed application forms should be returned to Playwork Partnerships. Please note, a minimum of 6 weeks prior to the start of the course is required for processing. The recommended student numbers are a maximum of 20 and a minimum of 6.



What materials are there for tutors?

The tutor resource materials for Everyone Can Play contain learning outcomes, lesson plans for all sessions, extensive tutor notes, assessment opportunities and student handouts.

What materials are there for students?

- An Everyone Can Play Student Training Pack containing course material, plus useful contact names and addresses of organisations supporting Inclusive Play.
- A book list promoting positive images of disability.
- Ideas on how to tackle discriminatory practices.

NVQ links will be explained to support students wishing to continue towards this qualification.

Is this course endorsed?

Yes. The course has been accepted onto the national framework of training. Students can be confident that the course will be recognised by employers anywhere in the country.
