## Everyone Can Play aims to:

- enable students to develop confidence and competence in working with disabled and non-disabled children aged 4 – 16 years in their leisure time.
- give students an understanding of Inclusive Play issues and Playwork values.
- provide valuable underpinning knowledge to support students wishing to register as a candidate for the NVQ level 2 in Playwork.

## How much time does Everyone Can Play take?

- Everyone Can Play is a 12.5 hour tutor lead course. This is usually over 5 sessions of 2.5 hours.
- Students are encouraged to undertake some personal study and if possible make visits to other play settings.

## What does Everyone Can Play cover?

- Introduction session, getting to know you
- Disability equality
- Children's well-being
- Equality of opportunity
- Planning for inclusive play



## Who can attend Everyone Can Play?

- Anyone working in play with children who wants to take an active part in making sure that non-disabled and disabled children can play together.
- A diversity of learning needs and styles will be recognised by your qualified tutor. This will be in line with our Equal Opportunities Policy.
- The course will be delivered in a manner that will fully include all students.

## Does Everyone Can Play carry a certificate?

- Yes. Everyone Can Play is certificated by Playwork Partnerships and endorsed by SkillsActive the Sector Skills Council for Active Leisure and Learning. It is linked to the National Occupational Standards and recognises skills, knowledge and understanding needed for some units of the NVQ Level 2 in Playwork.

## What do students have to do to receive the full Everyone Can Play certificate?

Students will receive an Everyone Can Play Certificate if they

- attend 80% of the tutor lead sessions
- complete a multi-choice questionnaire set by tutors
- show an awareness of playwork values
- show evidence of improved playwork practice

## What information and materials are provided?

- An Everyone Can Play student training pack containing course materials, plus useful contact names and addresses of organisations supporting inclusive play.
- A book list promoting positive images of disability.
- Ideas on how to tackle discriminatory practices.
- NVQ links will be explained to support students wishing to continue towards this qualification.

## How much will it cost?

- This will depend upon local arrangement.
