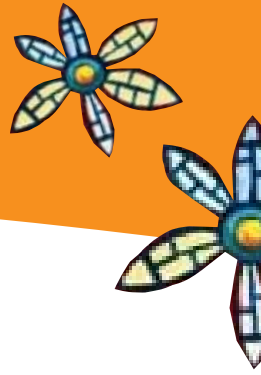


# Principles into Practice
