Play2gether - Inclusive Play Training

As Playworkers, Early Years workers and Childminders we can provide an inclusive playful environment that stimulates the imagination, offers challenges and the opportunity to build self confidence and raise self esteem so that both Disabled and Non-Disabled Children can prepare for the future together. The course is designed to introduce participants to the principles that underlie Inclusive Play.

It is anticipated that by the end of the day participants will have:

- Reflected on their attitude towards disability
- Demonstrated how to create inclusive activities for a variety of settings
- Examined the meaning of inclusive play
- Developed their understanding of the playwork principles
- Learnt a range of new games and how to adapt them

Play2gether is a one day interactive training course that uses games and activities that promote inclusiveness.

Play2gether is supported by a student workbook and offers a certificate.

The day is facilitated by a partnership of disabled and non-disabled trainers. Both have been delivering training for more than 20 years.

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
