

Play4All - Level 3 course

A four day inclusive management course
for Play, Early Years, Development
Officers & Youth workers

Purpose of the course

To improve the management of Inclusive practice in Play and Early Years.

Day 1 Building relationships to improve inclusive practice

Day 2 Exploring current practice and planning for change, including managing intimate assistance for Disabled Children and Young Disabled People

Day 3 Build on current management practice to implement strategic and operational change

Day 4 Managing flexible environments where children all can play

Target Audience - Experienced or Senior Play and Early Years Workers, Managers, Local Authority Development Workers.

Number of Students - Minimum: 6 Maximum: 16

Course Requirements - The course is delivered by two trainers over four teaching days spread over three months.

The first two days are delivered consecutively, a week later the third day, two months later the fourth and final day, there is fifteen hours of home study this includes - assignments and a visit to a peer setting. It is anticipated on the fourth day providing participants have completed the course requirements and met the assessment criteria, the tutors will be able to sign off and give out certification.
