



Scrappy Ideas - Two day Playwork Training Course

Aims of the course

To enable learners to feel confident and gain competence in the creative process and to explore the links between play and creativity through direct experience

Learning Outcomes: By the end of the course participants will of

- ❖ explored the play possibilities of scrap materials and loose parts
- ❖ gained confidence and develop practical skills that support the creative process
- ❖ developed an understanding of how creative play supports development
- ❖ explored the importance of reflective practice
- ❖ understand some of the theories that underpin playwork practice
- ❖ identified how to maintain a safe play environment including risk assessment and legal obligations

Target Audience: Playworkers, Early Years Workers, Childminders

Number of Students: Minimum: 6 - Maximum: 20

Course Requirements: Two day course which can run on consecutive or two single days, participants packs.
